PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 115? If not, the motion is to advance LB 115 from General File to Enrollment and Review for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carried. The bill is advanced. We will revert now back to the original agenda, LR 87. Senator Haberman, do you have a request on that? If there is no objection, we will pass over LB 87 (sic). So ordered. Senator Warner, you have a request on LB 481A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner made a motion yesterday to withdraw LB 481A. That is now before the Legislature.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, when that bill was advanced yesterday I indicated based on the fiscal note and I thought it could be withdrawn and it was not needed and for the reason I stated yesterday the fact that going to the biennial issuing of license plates was a dollar saving in the operation of the Bureau and with that provision there was no need for the A bill as there would be no increased costs. In fact, there is a reduction in cost. So I would ask that the bill be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to withdraw LB 481A. Is there discussion? If not, it requires 25 votes. All those in favor of withdrawing LB 481A vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk will record.
