Accused him of various political reasons, which I fully believe is what is occurring here, and from there went to the Lincoln Police Department, offered to take a polygraph test, spoke at some length with Detective Flansberg, set up a polygraph test. Left there, received a call from my wife. The police were back at the house, four of them, searching the house thoroughly. They finally found what they were looking for. A picture of my little girl when she was three or four sitting on a potty which they nobly seized. I became angry then. Went directly to a law firm here in town. Asked them to try to locate as soon as possible--the police department had all their polygraph operators busy and couldn't give an exam at that time--locate as quick as they could the best polygraph examiner in the nation. I was notified a couple of hours later they were bringing one in. Two were brought in, two separate firms. I spent most of last night doing a polygraph exam repeatedly. Here are the results of that I would like to hand out for anybody that wants them. I'll read you the--Page, would you hand these out? I'll just read you the last paragraph.
