that is what the bill does, it shifts liability for the negligence of a volunteer back to the company that caused the hazardous waste situation in the first instance, and then if you are talking about gross negligence, it would still remain the responsibility of the volunteer himself. Gross negligence, we are not changing that. That would not be the responsibility of the company creating the situation. I would ask for the adoption of the amendment, Mr. Speaker.

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: I would certainly agree with the amendment. It is fine as far as I am concerned. I would move for its adoption also.
