LB 745, 746, 747

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of LB 745? If not, Senator Barrett. Okay, the motion is to advance LB 745 from General File to E & R for review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is advanced. LB 746.

CLERK: Mr. President, 746 (read title). The bill was read on January 4 of this year, referred to the Business and Labor Committee for hearing. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barrett.

SENATOR BARRETT: Thank you, Mr. President and members, LB 746 simply amends the Nebraska Employment Security Law to conform it with changes in the requirements of the Federal Unemployment Tax Act, the FUTA act. It is a conformity bill. I think you will see in the bill book, it provides that if we ever pay benefits with advances of federal funds, interest required by the federal law on those advances can't be paid from the Unemployment Compensation Fund. Secondly, it treats employees of educational service agencies like employees of other educational institutions for purposes of disqualification of benefits and finally provides that when extended benefits are not in an even multiple of \$1, those benefits are rounded down rather than up. I would simply move the advancement of LB 746.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion of LB 746? If not, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of LB 746 from General File. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the bill is advanced. LB 747.
