LB 643, 851, 774

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the bill is advanced.  
LB 643.

CLERK: Mr. President, 643 (read title). The bill was read on January 4 of this year. It was referred to the Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee for hearing. It was advanced to General File. There are no amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, members of the body, this is what we call the annual wild card for credit unions. It is the bill that says that a state chartered credit union can do that which a federal chartered credit union can do. We pass this every year as we also do it for the...the same thing for our savings...for state chartered savings and loans. However, the savings and loan bill comes later. This is just the credit union bill. I move the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on LB 643? If not, the motion is to advance the bill from General File. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of LB 643. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: By that vote the bill is advanced. LB 774.

CLERK: Mr. President, 774 (read title). The bill was read on January 4 of this year. It was referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee.
