LB 216, 218

CLERK: 32 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The rules are suspended and we will move on to LB 216.

CLERK: (Read LB 216 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 599 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 11 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 4 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. Let's take up Senator Wesely's amendment on 218.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to return LB 218 to Select File for a specific amendment. (Wesely amendment appears on pages 599-602 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. Senator Goodrich and I have co-sponsored this amendment. It is brought to us by the Omaha school teachers and the Omaha Public Schools. Right now this legislation deals with employer pickup of employee retirement contributions. Everybody is in the bill that is a public employee now except for school teachers and the school teachers across the State of Nebraska have opted not to be included but now the Omaha school teachers did come to us and have talked to the public school system in Omaha and would like to be part of this legislation. That is all the amendment does. It adds them as one of the groups covered under it and I would ask your support at this time for the amendment.
