LB 896, 808

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we adopt the E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the Enrollment and Review committee amendments to LB 896. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move that we advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 896 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed say no. The motion carried, the bill is advanced. We are asked by Senator Fenger to pass over 723 because of an amendment in preparation. I guess then we will return to General File and we have...do you have anything to read in, Mr. Clerk? LB 808.

CLERK: Mr. President, 808 was a bill introduced by the Banking Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 5 of this year, referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee. It was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp for the committee amendments.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, last year as you know we did a major thing in passing LB 343 setting up central filing, central indexing, whatever you want to call it, system. We formed a council under that bill. These are amendments that have been agreed upon by everybody and various people affected by it. We have another bill so you don't confuse this one with 807. There are two of these. 807 still has some problems to be worked out with the county officials. However, this bill, as I say, has been agreed upon by
