everybody. The first section is just simply technical corrections and things that had to be done like any major bill. The second aspect of the committee amendments makes uniform filing fees. There was some conflict as to whether one dollar or two dollars was to be charged by somebody and who got the money. It straightens that out so everything is uniform there and everybody is singing all from the same hymn book on the thing. The third section does, and this is significant, it delays the full implementation of the central system until 1986. The reason for that is getting all the computer work done, getting the system tested out, this whole thing, figured they needed some additional time. Now it may be possible to get it done before then. We could make adjustments, if necessary, but at least this gives the flexibility. I move the adoption of the committee amendments.
