The amendment...the committee amendment as amended says that the taxpayer may check off one, five, ten or more dollars to the Nongame and Endangered Species Conservation Fund. The language in the original bill stated that the taxpayer should check off one, five or ten dollars. The committee amendment as amended simply adds the language, "or more" to the bill and allows the taxpayer receiving a refund to check off a greater amount than ten dollars. I urge the adoption of the committee amendments.
