LB 466, 466A, 152

CLERK: 27 ayes, 3 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 466 is advanced. LB 466A.

CLERK: 466A by Senator Labeledz. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Mr. President, I believe we can withdraw 466A because there is no fiscal impact since we adopted Senator Beutler's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to kill the bill then, Senator?

SENATOR LABEDZ: I make a motion that we withdraw or kill LB 466A.

PRESIDENT: In high-flown English, it is indefinitely postponed. Very well, the motion is to indefinitely postpone LB 466A. All those...is there discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the motion to indefinitely postpone or withdraw LB 466A as explained by Senator Labeledz. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to indefinitely postpone 466A.

PRESIDENT: 466A is indefinitely postponed. LB 152.

CLERK: Mr. President, 152 offered by Senator Fenger. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 11th of last year. At that time it was referred to the Public Works Committee. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. There are Public Works Committee amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, do you want to handle the committee amendments to LB 152? The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.
