SENATOR PIRSCH: We don't give hearing tests, do we, at our motor vehicle testing?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I've never been given a hearing test.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 811.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 811 advances. LB 990.

CLERK: Mr. President, 990 was a bill introduced by Senators Pappas, Eret, Haberman, Richard Peterson, and Chronister. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 12 of this year, referred to the Ag and Environment Committee for hearing. It was advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
