SENATOR GOODRICH: Go ahead.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, members of the body, all the purpose of this bill is to add two members to the board that, catch my breath here, two members to the board of that governs, not governs. It handles the private colleges and the problem is they're having a difficulty once in awhile getting a quorum and if we added two more board members to the group, they would then have a little larger pool to draw from to draw a quorum and that's all in the world the bill does, just add two new members to the board. It's their request to do it. I move we advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there a discussion on LB 644? If not, all those in favor of advancing LB 644 vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of LB 644. Please record your vote. Please record your vote on the advancement of LB 644. Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: LB 644 is advanced. LB 683.

CLERK: 683 by Senator Landis.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Landis here? Senator Landis, you were here just a moment ago. We're about ready to take up LB 683. Senator Landis, please report to the Chamber.

CLERK: 683, Mr. President, by Senator Landis. (Read title.) The bill read on January 4, referred to the Government Committee for hearing, advanced to General File. There are no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. LB 683E, advanced by the
