PRESIDENT: LB 663 passes with the emergency clause attached since there were 33 and more votes. On LB 911 we're asked to put that to the bottom of Final Reading, pass over it temporarily. LB 976 we understand has to wait for the arrival of an A bill that compliments it. Then I guess we are ready for LB 977 with the emergency clause.

We are coming back to it yet today. It still has some work to be done on it. Next, the Clerk will read LB 623.
