LB 1056

SENATOR H. PETERSON: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, if I can get rid of my friend's fudge here, I will be all right. As all of you know, we have a personnel survey every year made by the Personnel Department and presently the statute provides for a survey in the Lincoln and Omaha market both for private and public employees and what this bill would do would be to add the first class cities. My feeling has been for a long time as I sat on the committee that when we had this survey presented to us that we didn't get a really true picture of what was happening across the State of Nebraska and that many of our state employees are out across the state, including our state colleges, including our community colleges, including...well, you could just go on and on. So what the purpose of this is is to add the first class cities and I would move the adoption of LB 1056.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the motion is the advancement of LB 1056. Is there anyone else who wishes to speak on the subject? I have no lights on. Do you wish to say anything further, Senator Peterson?
