SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. LB 967 was in the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee and there was no descending votes and the Nebraska Council of Sportsman's Club and the Games and Parks Commission did appear in favor of the bill and also the Natural Resource Commission. And we, therefore, urge the members of the Legislature to advance LB 967. Is my mike on? Oh, I wasn't close enough.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Sieck.

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. President and members of the body, I also support this bill. I feel that the natural resource districts can live with it and they've been having problems getting funding for their projects and maybe this will help the funding of the particular project that they're building. So they know where they're going. At the present time, we have several projects out there that cannot get funding and they're depending upon the Appropriations Committee now this year to allow the funding for those particular projects. If we get these things okayed before the time, then we'll be assured that as the projects are built that there will be funding. Thank you.
