SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. The motion to hold has been withdrawn because of this amendment. There are a couple of provisions in this bill, Sections 15, 16, 17, and 18, that make reference to the Department of Administrative Services handling the grounds for not only the Capitol but the lands that we own adjacent to that, including the Governor's Mansion and others. The difficulty is that it plugs into some provisions that grant more substantial authority than that. And the 309 Committee has suggested that those provisions, as currently drafted, are inappropriate. I've agreed to that and I've asked to strike in this amendment, those sections. After the adoption of the amendment, I'll be happy to explain the balance of the bill that we'll be voting on. I would move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the Landis amendment. Yes, Senator Wagner.

SENATOR WAGNER: Yeah, Mr. Speaker...Mr. President and members. I had some concerns about the bill and it was in the Sections 15, 16, and 17 and there were five of us that signed the motion to withdraw 933 for consent, from the consent calendar. In talking with Senator Landis, we agreed upon striking those sections and it's kind of with that understanding that we adopt this, the Landis and Wagner amendment, striking those sections and in doing so, then we were in agreement. So, I would urge the adoption of that amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the Landis amendment? If not, all those in favor of the amendment vote aye, opposed vote nay. Voting on the Landis amendment to LB 933. Please record your vote. Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Landis-Wagner amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Landis-Wagner amendment is adopted. Senator Landis.
