But in addition to that, Senator George Norris was also interested in irrigation. The Tri-County project here in the State of Nebraska is a result of that. And let me tell you later on I started farming. I had never farmed before in my life and I started out dry land farming, and in that dry land farming if it doesn't rain for a couple of years, I will tell you it can make you pretty humble so you begin to appreciate the irrigation. And that was another item that Senator George Norris had is the Tri-County project and also the work that was done in the Republican Valley, and I have been involved with irrigation and after you dry out a few years you certainly do begin to appreciate irrigation. And more lastly I never had any idea that I would ever serve in the Unicameral and I guess that is really one of the highlights of my life. So there are three areas in which this man has impacted my life and I think it is very becoming to go ahead and name this Chamber after George Norris because I think he is one of the greatest Nebraskans we have had. I urge your adoption of that resolution.
