PRESIDENT: Motion fails. The Call of the House is raised. Clerk will read matters into the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Public Works, whose Chair is Senator Schmit, to whom was referred LB 968 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File, 1071 General File, 727 General File with committee amendments attached, 825 General File with committee amendments attached. Retirement Systems Committee, whose Chair is Senator Wesely, reports LB 751 to General File, 971 to General File, 855 indefinitely postponed, and 1094 indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Wesely. (See page 991 of the Legislative Journal.)

Senator Labeledz would move to suspend Rule 7, Section 7, and reconsider the motion to indefinitely postpone LB 466A. That will be laid over.
