It is a grammatical purpose for doing exactly the same purpose that we talked about on Select File.

SENATOR BARRETT: Thank you. I would then support the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the proposed amendment? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment as explained by Senator Landis. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: The amendment having been adopted, I move the readvancement of LB 405.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to readvance LB 405. Is there discussion? If not, all those in favor of advancing the bill say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is readvanced. Move on now to LB 703.

CLERK: (Read LB 703 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 703 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Voting on final passage of LB 703. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1093 of the Legislative
