LB 694, 694A

and I have a gubernatorial report from the Constitution Revision and Recreation Committee regarding confirmation hearing, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Nothing else on the bill. We are back on the bill. Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: I would move for the advancement of LB 694.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the advancement of LB 694. Record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: I am going to have to ask for a roll call... a Call of the House.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 1 nay to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The House is under Call. Will you please return to the Legislative Chamber and record your presence. Ladies and gentlemen, we are going to have to do better than this if we are going to get through your priority bills this session. Senator Labeledz said she will accept call ins.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting no. Senator Remmers voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill advances. Reluctantly raise the Call. LB 426. Oh, Senator Labeledz, did you wish to take your A bill, LB 694A? Senator Labeledz. Senator Labeledz, may
