CLERK: 38 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill advances. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything that you would like to put in?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Mr. President, Senator Rod Johnson has amendments to LB 994. (See pages 1193-1194 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Public Works whose Chair is Senator Schmit reports LB 766 and 1060 to General File with committee amendments. That is signed by Senator Schmit. (See pages 1193-1194 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, a new A bill, 314A (Read for the first time by title. See page 1194 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, your committee on Appropriations whose Chair is Senator Warner to whom was referred LB 883 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File; 874 indefinitely postponed, and that is signed by Senator Warner. Public Health reports 1127 to General File, Mr. President, and 839 to General File with committee
