

you have the right to contact a lawyer, it doesn't mean that you can tie up the telephone all night trying to call lawyers, lawyers, lawyers. There can be a reasonable restriction placed on the number of calls. Usually they give you one. If they know you, they might give you more than one. Sometimes they will even make calls for you or advise as to a lawyer that you can call who will handle these kind of things, but because this type of activity is already handled in other areas of the criminal law, it will not require any new procedures to be put in place. It is a familiar procedure and I am telling you that the Lincoln Police Division does it already. They came to the hearing only because they wanted to be sure that the bill was not going to prevent them from taking their test prior to the person being informed about a physician. But once I made it clear and adopted language by amendment that said they can take their test first, the Lincoln Police Department not only had no objection to the bill, but they voluntarily gave me a copy of the advice that they give to people accused.

SENATOR LUNDY: Okay, and it is not necessary then that the officers wait for him to make two or three calls and it will not void anything that has been done by them when it comes to the court case if that person does not get his physician?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, the officer is not required to provide a physician or make sure that the person can get one. The officer is required to notify the person that they have that option. Then his duty ends as far as what I am doing is concerned.
