CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on advancement of 642.

PRESIDENT: LB 642 is advanced. LB 863.

CLERK: (Read title.) It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee for hearing. It was advanced to General File. Mr. President, the introducer, Senator Warner, has an amendment to his bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this is a bill that grants an easement across a portion of the Fairgrounds for a sanitary sewer that is to be put in. The amendment corrects the legal description for the location of that sewer. I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the amendment? If not, all those in favor of the Warner amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on an amendment offered by Senator Warner to LB 863. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I perhaps didn't explain the amendment. All that did was correct a legal description. What the bill does is it concurs in an easement across a portion of the Fairgrounds for a new sanitary sewer that in part drains a variety of areas in northeast...or northwest Lincoln but it will help sewer the Sports Center and other parts of Lincoln in that area.
