LB 689, 760, 872, 1016, 1051, 1074, 883

LB 1016. The motion is to advance LB 1016. Have you all voted? Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: LB 1016 is advanced. Next is matters for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, very quickly Education reports LB 1051 to General File with amendments; 689, 872, 1074 indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Vickers.

I have a confirmation hearing report from the Education Committee. I have two of those reports, Mr. President.

I have a report of registered lobbyists for this past week.

Mr. President, Senator Newell would like to add his name to LB 760 as co-introducer.

PRESIDENT: Without objection, so ordered. Next is LB 883.

CLERK: (Read title.) The bill was read on January 6, referred to Appropriations, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes the Speaker, Senator Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This appropriates \$251,750 for your salaries. I move for the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion? If not, all those in favor of advancing LB 883 vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of the legislative salaries bill, LB 883. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to
