Mr. President, LB 826 offered by Senator Wesely. (Read title). The bill was read on January 5, referred to the Government Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, LB 826 originally carried a rather hefty increase in the salary for the Attorney General. We struck that provision from the bill and we made this operative section to be in essence the bill. The Attorney General and all permanent Deputy and Assistant Attorney Generals shall not engage in the private practice of law for compensation or lobbying for compensation. Essentially, that is the practice of the office and has been informally for the last several years and this places that in the statute. I would move for the adoption of the committee amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Excuse me, Senator Warner, I'm sorry.
