CLERK: Mr. President, there is a second report by the Education Committee on the appointment of Dave Domina to the Educational Lands and Funds.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President and members, the committee again supported the confirmation of David Domina to the Board of Educational Lands and Funds and would ask for a favorable vote to accept that confirmation report.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any discussion on the confirmation report? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Confirmation report.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the report, Mr. President. (See pages 1292-1293 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CLARK: The report is adopted. We'll now go to number seven, first bill, 1076. Do you have something to read in? We're going to take the second bill, 693.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may right before that, your committee on Revenue whose Chair is Senator Carsten to whom is referred Legislative Bill 706 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation be indefinitely postponed; 731, 770, 817, 831, 869, 888, 937 and 955; all those signed by Senator Carsten as Chair, Mr. President. Mr. President, Legislative Bill 693 introduced by Senator John DeCamp. (Read title.) It was read on January 4, referred to the Banking, Commerce, and Insurance Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.
