SENATOR SCHMIT: I hate to have to ask for a Call of the House but...

CLERK: Senator Wagner voting yes. Senator Eret voting yes. Senator Newell voting yes. Senator Withem voting yes. Senator Hefner voting yes. Senator DeCamp voting yes. Senator Kilgarin, you had voted yes, Senator. Senator Lowell Johnson voting yes. Senator Carsten voting yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Schmit amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?
