SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 985.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Only if Senator Landis cares to speak, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Microphone turned off)...Senator Schmit's bill. I think he opens on the bill for a motion to advance, does he not?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, not necessarily. It's on Select and if he wishes to speak to it, he could but he chose to speak after you do.
