SENATOR KAHLE: Senator Newell or Senator Beutler. Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: If we can find Senator Newell, Mr. Speaker, he is going to withdraw that amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, while we are waiting for Senator Newell, Senators Pappas and Newell have an amendment on page 1331 in the Journal.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, this amendment that we reintroduced, Senator Newell and I, supercedes the one he is going to withdraw very shortly. It is a compromise amendment worked out with the Department of Revenue that clarifies the language. The Revenue Department is in favor of it. All parties are in favor of it. I ask for the advancement of the amendment.

SENATOR KAHLE: Is there any discussion? If not, those in favor of the amendments say aye. They tell me we need a machine vote. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Kahle voting yes.

SENATOR KAHLE: Please vote. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Pappas' and Newell's amendment. I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR KAHLE: Senator Pappas, would you like to close or inform us about the bill?

SENATOR PAPPAS: I would move advancement of the bill.

SENATOR KAHLE: All those in favor vote aye, those opposed no. The bill is advanced. LB 933.
