LB 694A, 993

SENATOR LABEDZ: Mr. President, I would request that we pass over 694A as amended. I doubt whether we're going to need an A bill. I don't want to make the mistake of asking for...Mr. Speaker just told me that I should advance LB 694A and keep it along with LB 694 in case there is a need for it. As of now there will be no need for 694A, but we should move them on together in case there is any changes on Final Reading.

SENATOR CLARK: The question is the advancement of 694A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed...

SENATOR MARSH: Machine vote.

SENATOR CLARK: Machine vote has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted on the advancement of 694A? Once more, have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is advanced. I've been told there is still some technical difficulties with 776, so we're going to pass over that. We'll go to LB 993.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have E & R amendments to 993.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Johnson. Senator Harris.

SENATOR HARRIS: Mr. President, I move that the E & R amendments be adopted.

SENATOR CLARK: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Harris.
