CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1403-04 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. LB 746 with the emergency clause attached.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 746 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. With the emergency clause and it takes 33 votes. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1403-04 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 2 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 746 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 705.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 705 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1405-06 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is...

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 705 passes.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The vote is 43 ayes, 2 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 2 present and voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Now LB 705 passes. While the Legislature is in session and capable of doing business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 1026, LB 405 and LB 746. LB 644 with the emergency clause attached.
