LB 881, 897, 899

SENATOR CLARK: All those in favor of readvancing the bill say aye. Opposed. The bill is readvanced. Go to LB 897.

CLERK: (LB 897 read on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1420 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 2 present not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. We'll take up 899E, if we could have a little quiet in the House please. (Gavel.) Everyone is supposed to be in their seats.

CLERK: (Final Reading of LB 899.)

SENATOR CLARK: All provisions of law according to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. It takes 33 votes.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 1421 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is declared passed. Senator Higgins, for what purpose do you rise?
