Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1000 passes. LB 1032.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1032 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1475 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1032 passes. LR 2CA.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Pirsch would move to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Members of the body, this poor beleaguered bill is back before you once again. It has been diddled around for so long that I need to make a change in the time that it will be on the ballot for the people. No problem as far as the enactment of it but just something that has to be done. This will change the May date to the November date. In the process if you will recall, Senator Chambers had a problem with the word "confiscated" and so also part of this amendment we did change that to "seized" to be in confirmation with the other kinds of statutes and constitutional amendments. Thank you.
