SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I move we advance LB 776.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 692.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item I have to 692 are E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, I move we adopt the E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, now I have a series of amendments. The first is offered by Senator Hoagland. Senator Hoagland would move to amend by adding the emergency clause.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, this amendment would add the emergency clause. I understand that there is no opposition to the amendment. I would move its adoption. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion to adopt the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It requires 25 votes. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Hoagland's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Hoagland amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to amend. The DeCamp amendment is on page 1458 of the Journal.
