SENATOR BARRETT: A question of Senator Warner, Mr. President. Senator Warner, I am still confused concerning Senator Johnson's concerns here on the Beginning Farmer Act. 1126 appropriated \$120,000. Now you are eliminating how much? You are eliminating \$20,000?

SENATOR WARNER: \$120,000.

SENATOR BARRETT: You are eliminating \$120,000.

SENATOR WARNER: The presumption is that that would be part of an A bill for the enabling legislation itself.

SENATOR BARRETT: All right, thank you, and then you are also eliminating the \$150,000 from 1117, I believe...

SENATOR WARNER: That is right.

SENATOR BARRETT: ...and the third deletion was what?

SENATOR WARNER: \$470,000 which is the...

SENATOR BARRETT: The communications.

SENATOR WARNER: ...the communications, 1125.

SENATOR BARRETT: Those are the three deletions. And then your second amendment will concern some other appropriations.

SENATOR WARNER: Right, it has a noble but different cause.
