PRESIDENT: Very well, we are on General File. We go to item 8 on your agenda for the consideration of LB 229.

CLERK: Mr. President, 229 introduced by Senator Beutler. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 13 of last year, Mr. President. It was referred to the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee for public hearing. On February 15 of this year, Mr. President, the committee amendments were adopted. There was then an amendment offered by Senator Beutler that was divided and the first portion of that amendment was adopted, Mr. President. I now have pending the second portion of Senator Beutler's amendment which is on page...

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, I wish to withdraw that second half of the amendment and I will reoffer it on Select File. Senator Chambers has objections to that amendment and we are going to have a detailed discussion of it, I am sure, at one point or another. But rather than have that discussion twice on a point this small, I would ask to withdraw the amendment and I will resubmit it on Select File and we can argue it at that time. And then perhaps we can advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: Is the bill in a position for a motion to advance?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to move, Senator?

SENATOR BEUTLER: So move, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Beutler moves that LB 229 be advanced from General File to Enrollment and Review for review. Is
