LB 724, 941, 830

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Next we have...matters for the record, Mr. Clerk. Do you have anything? The Call of the House is raised. Thank you, Senator Marsh.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Fenger would like to print amendments to LB 724 and Senator Kahle to 941. (See pages 1614-1615 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Next we move to LB 830.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 830 introduced by Senator Warner. (Title read.) The bill was read on January 5 of this year. It was referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. There are committee amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten, for committee amendments, yes.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I would move for the adoption of the committee amendment. The committee amendment on page 2, line 10, after conducted insert "prior to January 1, 1988." What this basically is, is a sunset provision for the bill. That is the only change in the bill that the committee made. I would be remiss if I did not at this point alert you to a possibility that this may not be in proper conformity to the bonding provisions that are involved in this process and perhaps, not knowing at this point, if we do have a conflict there, that perhaps on Select File that date may be changed to conform to that. But at the moment at least I would urge you to adopt the sunset provision of January 1, 1988.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Carsten. Is there further discussion on the Revenue Committee amendments to LB 830? If not, the motion is to adopt the committee amendments.
