SENATOR GOODRICH: Okay then what is left in the bill now is if the Eagles Club, the Elks Club, Knights of Columbus, Shriners, that sort of thing, if they all have...if any of them have some form of alcoholic beverage served in their clubs, that sort of thing, they are going to be taxed on that portion of their club if they serve alcoholic beverages more than twenty hours in any one week's time?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Yes, that is correct. That is in current law, right.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Okay, I've got a real problem with this, Cal. I don't see how I can support it, I'm sorry to say it. Thank you.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, members, I wonder if Senator Carsten would respond to a question, please.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Sure.

SENATOR VICKERS: Senator Carsten, in answer to Senator Goodrich you indicated you had taken out the section that dealt with the unapproved schools.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Yes.

SENATOR VICKERS: Could you expand as to why the committee took that out just a little bit more.
