SENATOR CARSTEN: For the very basic reason that we projected it as we originally drafted the bill, it was too restrictive and that it should not be in the bill, should not be a part of the bill and should be removed as well as some other things that we struck.

SENATOR VICKERS: So if I understand correctly, you are indicating that the unapproved schools are illegal anyhow and that we shouldn't grant tax exemptions in any case for things that were illegal and as far as operations are concerned. Would that be a good...?

SENATOR CARSTEN: I think that would be correct, yes.
