SENATOR LABEDZ: We are voting on the advancement of LB 711. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nays, Madam Chair, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Nichol, I believe there is an A bill. (LB 711A.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, I believe it is something around \$1,500. At first the Department of Motor Vehicles was going to take it, then they thought they probably better not with the money crunch, so I move for the advancement of the A bill and I think it is in the neighborhood of \$1,500.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Nichol, there are no lights on for the A bill. We are voting for the advancement of LB 711A. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please vote. Have you all voted? Senator Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, I hate to ask for a Call of the House for one vote but...okay, thank you.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Record. Mr. Speaker, I believe you want to go to LB 890? (Vote on LB 711A was 26 ayes, 0 nays as found on page 1712 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, 890 and then one other beside that, Madam Speaker, that has to do...what's the number of that...?

SENATOR LABEDZ: 1084.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, 1084. Those two and then I think we
