development program and it also talks about a fund of \$50 per teacher for those districts to develop their in-service programs for their staff and this amendment would insert for this next fiscal year \$1,025,000 for that staff development and in-service program. I believe it is important that we do try to assist those districts. I guess I would characterize this as doing things. It would help the taxpayers as far as property taxes are concerned. It would also encourage the school districts to better provide staff development and in-service for their existing teachers. I would ask for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the motion? On the amendment to amend? If not, the motion is to adopt this amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on this Vickers amendment to LB 994A. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Vickers amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Vickers, the bill is in order to move.
