SENATOR CLARK: Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I am going to have to rise and oppose the committee amendments, oppose any reduction in the gasohol tax. Thank you, so I will oppose the committee amendments.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any further debate on the committee amendments? If not, all those in favor of the committee amendments vote aye, opposed vote nay. Did you want to close on those?

SENATOR CARSTEN: If I could just make a short statement to the committee amendments and the comments that Senator Warner made, there has been some change since we heard the bill at the hearing. I would concur with that and I think perhaps many of us have had a change of heart relative to this situation since this bill was originally heard in the hearing. With that, I guess that would be my close and you use your own judgment to do what you want to with the committee amendments.

SENATOR CLARK: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the committee amendments? Record the vote.

CLERK: 4 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CLARK: The committee amendments are not adopted. Now on the bill, do you have any amendments to the bill?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, the introducer, Senator Warner, Senator, I believe that you had amendments printed on page 1334 it is your wish to withdraw and substitute, is that correct? What is the amendment you want to offer, Senator, 2558 I believe?

SENATOR WARNER: Correct.
