SENATOR MCDONALD: Mr. President, I rise to support the Landis amendment. Quite briefly, as he has stated, it is an agreement worked out by the parties involved, the employers and the employee bargaining units. And with that, I would urge the adoption of the Landis amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. It takes 25 votes.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment is adopted. The next amendment.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. McDonald.

SENATOR MCDONALD: Mr. President, I move for advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: Is there any debate on the advancement of the bill? If not, all those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting yes.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 832, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The bill is advanced. We go to 832A.
