LB 809A, 956A

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp requesting record vote. (Read the record vote as found on page 1849 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt Senator Newell's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Anything else on the bill?

CLERK: No, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is the advancement of LB 809A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 2 nays, on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 809A is advanced. We will move on to LB 956A, but before we do, I would like to introduce some guests of Senator Goodrich and Senator Labeledz just coming into the south balcony. They are 66 Eighth Grade students from St. Thomas More School in Omaha, Nebraska, and their teacher is Kathy Wilcox. They are in the south balcony. Would you please welcome them to the Legislature. LB 956A.

CLERK: 956A by Senator Eret. (Read title.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is to advance LB 956A. Senator Eret, would you like to tell us about the A bill.

SENATOR ERET: Yes. Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, LB 956A is a fund adjustment to homestead exemptions for low income retired people of \$785,000. I would move for adoption of this bill at this time. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of LB 956A. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 956A, Mr. President.
