LB 970A, 981, 1106, 902

PRESIDENT: The motion fails.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Scofield, do you want to...Senator Vickers, do you want to advance the bill?

SENATOR VICKERS: I would just move for the advancement of LB 970A.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to advance the bill. All those in favor...

SENATOR MARSH: Machine vote.

PRESIDENT: Machine vote. You have heard the motion to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The motion is to advance LB 970A from Select File to Enrollment and Review for Engrossment. Please record your vote. 20 seconds allowed for recording of votes. The motion is the advancement of LB 970A. Please record your vote. Ten seconds. Five seconds. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted and the bill is advanced. LB 902.

CLERK: Mr. President, right before that, if I may, I have a confirmation report from the Public Health and Welfare Committee. (See page 1952 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Very well.

CLERK: I have amendments from Senator Lamb to 1106 and from Senator Newell to 981. (See pages 1952-55 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, 902, the first item I have to the bill are E & R amendments.
