PRESIDENT: We are happy to announce this morning on behalf of our Speaker, Senator Nichol, that he has visitors from his part of the state. Can we have a report from Senator Fenger's committee?

CLERK: Mr. President, the Public Health and Welfare report chaired by Senator Fenger is found on page 1952.

PRESIDENT: The Chair...(gavel)...can we have order in the Chamber, please. Senator Fenger.

SENATOR FENGER: Thank you, Mr. President. After public hearing, the committee forwarded for legislative confirmation the following people: Dr. Greg Wright as Director of the Department of Health; Mrs. Helen Boosalis, Director of the Department of Aging; two individuals to the State Foster Care Review Board; two to the Advisory Committee of the Department of Public Institutions; and five members to the State Board of Health. These names are all advanced for the body's consideration with the unanimous vote of those present in the committee. At this point I would move the adoption of the report, sir.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the committee report? If not, all those in favor of adopting Senator Fenger's confirmation report vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the committee's confirmation report? The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the confirmation report, Mr. President.
