ASSISTANT CLERK: The vote is 44 ayes, 3 nays, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President. (Vote appears on page 2083 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. LB 993.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 993 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The vote is 40 ayes, 8 nays, 1 present and not voting. (Vote appears on pages 2083-2084 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 993 passes. LB 1007. Senator Remmers, just a minute.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Remmers would move to return LB 1007 to Select File for a specific amendment. That amendment is found on page 1850.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Remmers.

SENATOR REMMERS: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I ask that you return this bill for a couple of technical corrections. The Public Service Commission has informed me that where I have used "warehouse keepers" the term should have been "warehouse licensee". That appears about a half a dozen places in the bill. I would like to change that to "warehouse licensee" and then they also object to the line where I had said the "irrevocable letter of credit or certificate of deposit shall be insured...shall be issued by the depository institutions and insured by an agency of the United States Government." They don't like that. They would rather have me say, "irrevocable letter of credit or certificate of deposit shall be issued by a federal insured depository institution." I would ask that
