SENATOR REMMERS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I ask that you approve the amendment that we have just mentioned.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the amendment by Senator Remmers. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, on adoption of Senator Remmers' amendment. Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Remmers amendment is adopted. Senator Remmers.

SENATOR REMMERS: I move that we move the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion to return the bill. All those in favor say aye, opposed nay. It is returned. LB 1016.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1016 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Higgins, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR HIGGINS: Mr. Teacher or Speaker, Senator Lamb is out of his seat.

SPEAKER NICHOL: By golly he is. He doesn't seem concerned about it. We will get the red coat on him. Record,
