LB 470, 700A

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Fenger amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to indefinitely postpone the bill. That would lay it over unless the introducer agrees to take it up at this time.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner. What is the decision?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Lay it over.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Lay it over? All right, it is laid over. LB 470A also? LB 700A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 700A is on Select File. The bill has failed to advance one time previously, Mr. President. I have nothing on the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Rod Johnson. Senator Landis, do you want to move it for us, please?

SENATOR LANDIS: Sure. I move the advancement of LB 700A.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Machine vote. We almost got it, didn't we, Bernice? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. (Gavel.) Let's have it a little bit quiet, please. Have you all voted? Senator Labedz, do you wish to have a Call of the House? The question is, shall the House go under Call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Now you may vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 5 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The House is under Call. Will you please return to your desks and record your presence. Those outside the Chamber please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Thank you. Please record your presence. Senator Labedz, would you please record your presence. Okay. Thank you. Senator Lowell Johnson. Thank you. Senator Goodrich. Senator McDonald. Thank you. Senator Chambers, please. Thank you.
