LB 507, 507A, 568A

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 507 passes. LB 507A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 507A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 2156-57 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 35 ayes, 6 nays, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. LB 568.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a request. Senator Vickers, I understand that you have an amendment to the A bill. Okay.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We will pass over 568 and then we will go to 568A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vickers would move to return 568A to Select File for a specific amendment. (Read the Vickers amendment as found on page 2157 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President and members, this is something I really don't want to do but I suspect that it is something we are going to have to do because this body has made some decisions that it would seem to me that at least some of the members of this body have indicated what their priorities and their decisions are. My own personal priority is that we, as I have indicated many times on this floor, that we provide property tax relief through state aid and I am willing to set the tax rates accordingly. And we haven't as a Legislature made that determination yet as to what the tax rates are going to be. But there are those people who have already made the determination in their own
